TITLE: Earrings – crochet lace

Duration: 3 hours

Description: Crochet lace with Lurex thread to create stylish and light earrings.

Crochet around a ring-shaped frame with shiny, thin thread.

The design is reminiscent of an Oriental adornment.

The possibilities of this design are endless. Experience crocheting is necessary.

Kit (to pay to the artist at the beginning of the session): 12€

The kit contains: Indian Lurex threads in a variety of colors (you may choose your colors), cotton threads, rings, brass chains and fasteners, small central pearl and design grid.

For this lesson, the students must bring: Crochets #1, 5 and 2, scissors and needles.

TITLE: Pouch – envelope, mirror embroidery

Duration: 3 hours

Description: Embroidered mirrors is a technique used to ennoble fabrics throughout India. It offers a multitude of possibilities by adding weight to the fabrics. Another common technique is that of folding the embroidered fabric into four parts thus creating a small pouch. These form part of Indian folk arts.

Embroider a square fabric: add mirrors using an Indian technique, embroider designs, scallop-stitched borders. Fold and sew the square fabric to create an envelope.

Kit (to pay to the artist at the beginning of the session): 18€

The kit contains: Square fabric, mirrors of various sizes, threads, silk cords, embroidery cottons, a small bell for the fastener and technical instructions for the mirror embroidery.

For this lesson, the students must bring: different sizes of embroidery needles, (sewing thread and embroidery cotton thread), thimble and scissors.

Required level: Embroidering and scallop-stitching experience is required. However, no embroidering hoop is necessary.
